On December 3, 2024, the author conducted interviews to obtain information about the church assembly's understanding of the concepts and aspects of spiritual

leadership. On this occasion, the author conducted an interview and met with the leader of the Toraja Church assembly of the Londa congregation, Mr. Pdt. Marthinus Patambing, S.Th, as the leader of the church assembly of the congregation. On this occasion, the author and he discussed how essential aspects of spiritual leadership are built in a leader. MP explained that spiritual leadership is an important aspect that must be owned and built at all times in a leader, especially when the leader is in a place with members of a plural group, not just one group or category. He continued that amid the digital era, which significantly impacts the sustainability of church life, especially youth (Generation *Z*), a fundamental goal is needed that can move and unite them in beautiful harmony.

The goal is that youth are not lost and alienated from the church. Christ was an exemplary leader who truly impacted the lives of His followers. This can be witnessed clearly in Christ's ministry when He was able to reach out and embrace the lives of each of His followers, all circles and groups Jesus entered. Especially marginalized people who were not considered in the understanding and context of life at that time. He further asked what an obstacle is at this time. Our hope, especially as a leader, is that in today's rapid technological era, Generation Z should be able to place themselves and declare their existence in the middle of the church. I hope the youth will be much more sensitive in understanding their calling amid the congregation. MP stated that for now, in expressing a stance as a church leader by

looking at the various digital challenges that exist, by looking at several indicators and factors that exist, especially since I have only been in the congregation for a few months, there are so many things that I have to learn first and understand well why youth are increasingly degenerating in terms of their relationship with our community and worship. Therefore, the first concrete step I can take is approaching the youth and building a much closer and stronger relationship. For now, I don't think that understanding spiritual well-being, namely calling and membership, has been well-embedded and awakened in the youth. This is because if this had been well-established, it is unlikely that the youth would have experienced such a significant decline in faith as witnessed in the congregation today. The youth are still too busy and indifferent to building intense relationships in the fellowship. Individualism and FOMO are still so tightly embedded in them that they have been unable to create accurate self-awareness to see this phenomenon.

On the same date, December 3, 2025, the author interviewed the chairman of the PPGT Londa congregation, who is also the Church Council. In his understanding, he said that spiritual leadership is certainly an important thing in a leader. This is certainly something that must be part of a leader. As a youth leader, I believe that building an impactful vision in the digital age starts with understanding the technological, social, and spiritual needs of our congregation. The first step is to conduct an assessment of the congregation's potential through open discussion and needs assessment. Next, the vision should be inclusive, relevant, and encourage crossgenerational cooperation. Utilizing digital platforms such as social media, apps, or church websites to hold daily devotionals, online Bible classes, or interactive online discussion rooms are examples. Consequently, this vision meets the spiritual needs of the congregation and is appropriate for the technological age. The congregation must have a firm and responsive faith. The congregation should not be afraid to face the digital age. In addition, as leaders, we must set an example by utilizing technology for ministry. They should be proactive in starting digital programs such as online worship, technology training, and virtual communities.

Furthermore, in this research the author interviewed youth who belong to generation Z. Spiritual leadership, in my opinion, is similar to helping others to get closer to God. Spiritual leaders are not just people who lead prayers or worship, but they also set an example in their daily lives by showing compassion, kindness, and helping others understand their faith. Spiritual leaders are also attentive to people's spiritual needs and help everyone feel

welcome in the church, although I don't fully understand it yet. Keeping focused on the right things and building faith amidst a lot of distracting digital content is my biggest challenge. I often feel too preoccupied with worldly things, such as comparing myself to others, because of social media. It's also hard to find dedicated time to read the Bible or pray because you're often tempted by games or videos. Being part of a church community is about learning together and supporting each other, in my opinion. I try to participate in youth activities, such as attending worship or mutual aid events, although I don't fully understand the calling yet. I believe that spending more time getting to know God and learning from people in the church community can improve spiritual well-being. I sometimes feel present, but sometimes I don't. When everyone is friendly and engaged with activities, I feel welcome. However, because I haven't gotten too close to many people, I sometimes feel awkward. Maybe it's because I'm new to this fellowship.
